These sustainable design choices include green roofs, solar panels, stormwater reuse, low-carbon concrete and of course locally sourced mass timber.

Cascada also features biophilic design elements as a means of connecting building occupants to nature and each other. This is especially notable in the building's lobby and the second floor walkway to the spa reception, with exposed Mass Ply Panels overhead and a living green wall spanning two floors. The real estate developer, SolTerra, dubbed Cascada "a sanctuary where wellness and sustainability meet."

Cascada features a three-story Spa and Fitness facility, including "Portland's first underground thermal springs," vitality pools, saunas and relaxation spaces.
